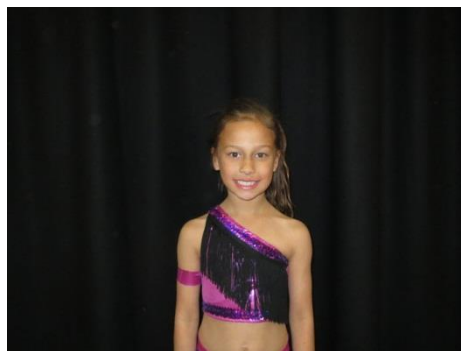
Sadleir's Got Talent

In first place was Kiara, Hope and Faith Tui dancing to a traditional Samoan song called 'Tausagi Mai Manu E'.



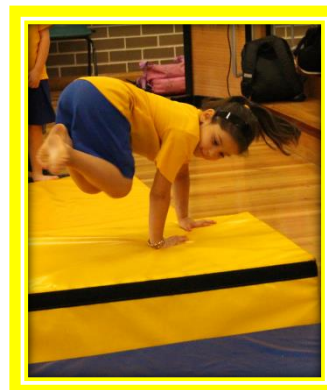
Congratulations to all the finalists and to everyone that auditioned. The SRC raised close to \$200, which will go towards buying new resources for our school.
