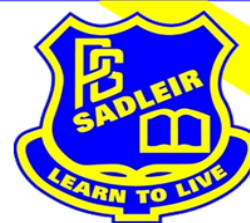

Punctuality

Thank you to the family and friends who came to watch our team on the day. We always appreciate your support. Mrs Brown - Coach

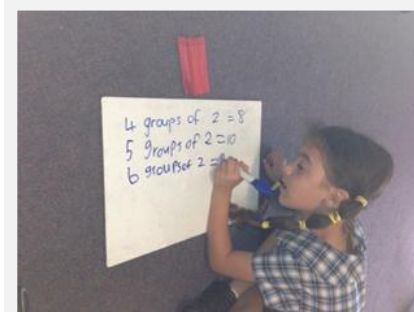
