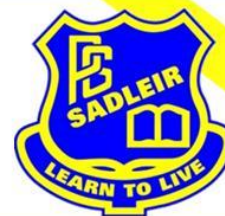

Principal's Report

Preschool 2014

Preschool enrolments for 2014 are now being accepted. While there are still vacancies at this stage, they may not last long. Therefore, if you have a child turning 4 before July 31, 2014, and they will be starting Kindergarten in 2015, I urge you to come and pick up an application form as soon as possible. Preschool fees are very reasonable and priority will be given to children residing in the Sadleir local area.

Father's Day Stall

Don't forget that the P&C will be holding their Father's Day Stall next Thursday. All gifts are \$5 and students from Preschool to Year 6 have received a note explaining how to purchase a small gift for dad. Thank you to the P&C for organising this event for your children.

Animals On School Grounds

I would like to reinforce the message that domestic animals, including dogs, are not allowed on school premises, even if they are on a leash. Walking your children to school, accompanied by the family pet is a great thing to do in terms of exercise but the dog must not come onto the school grounds. Many younger children are very wary of dogs and can become quite upset. I ask you to please respect this and say goodbye at the gate.

Head Lice

From time to time in all schools there will be instances of head lice. If it is evident in your

child's class a note will be sent home informing you of this and I ask that you take the time to look through your child's hair.

Some people believe that head lice are associated with "dirty hair". This is not always the case. You can help prevent their spread by:

- tying back your child's hair where possible
- sending a clearly labelled hat to school each day
- reminding your child not to touch or play with anyone's hair

If you do happen to find some head lice here are some easy to follow steps:

- obtain hair conditioner and a fine head lice comb
- apply the conditioner to the hair and comb through with a wide-toothed comb to remove the tangles. (The conditioner helps to slow down the louse and makes it easier to comb out.)
- then use a fine metal lice comb to remove the lice and pull the nits off the hair
- ensure all bed linen, towels, washers etc are washed in hot water

School Car Parks

Just a reminder that the school grounds are not to be used for parent parking, or as a drop off / pick up zone for students. This applies to both mornings and afternoons and particularly if students are arriving late or leaving early. As you would expect there are many young children at school each day and this is a real



safety issue. Please respect the signs at both gates.

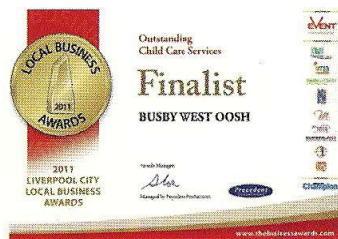
