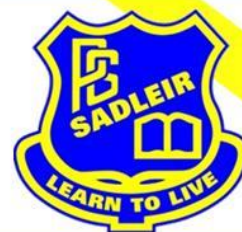

Next we fed a baby lamb a bottle, it was so cute! After this we fed bread to lambs, goats and deer. They were so greedy and even tried to eat our clothes!



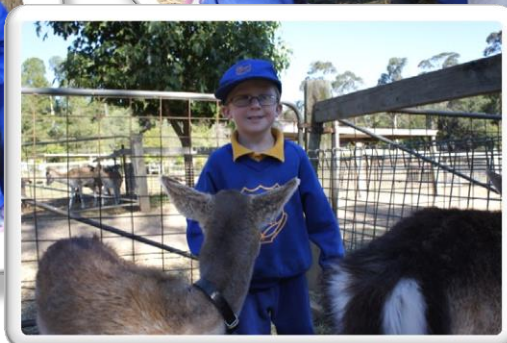

We milked a cow!

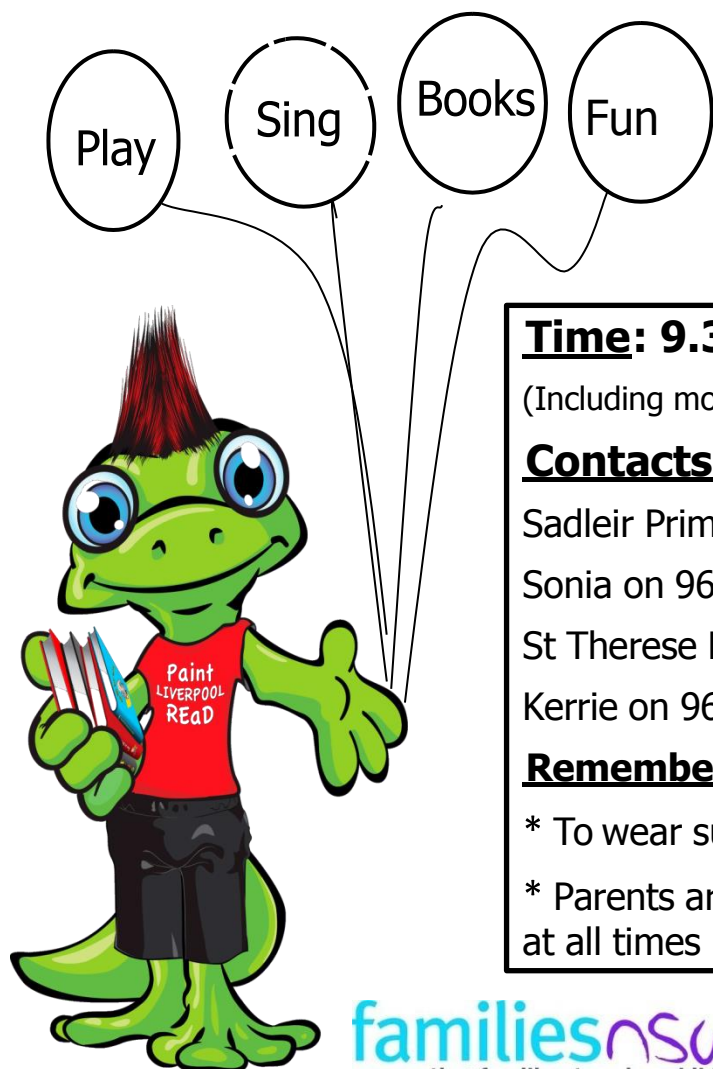
