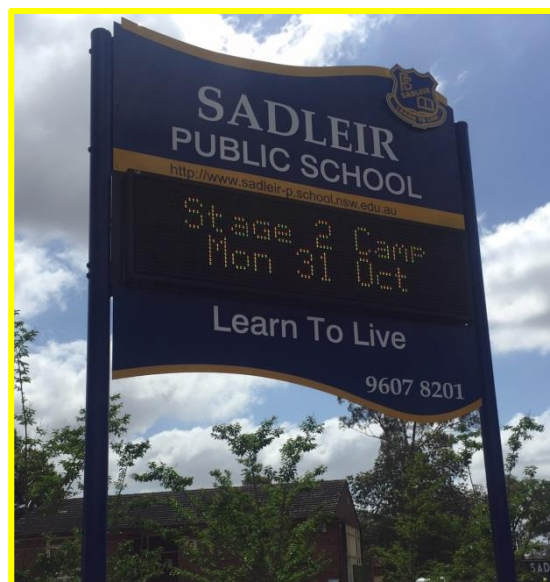
Staff Professional Learning

Water falls back to earth as rain, hail or snow.



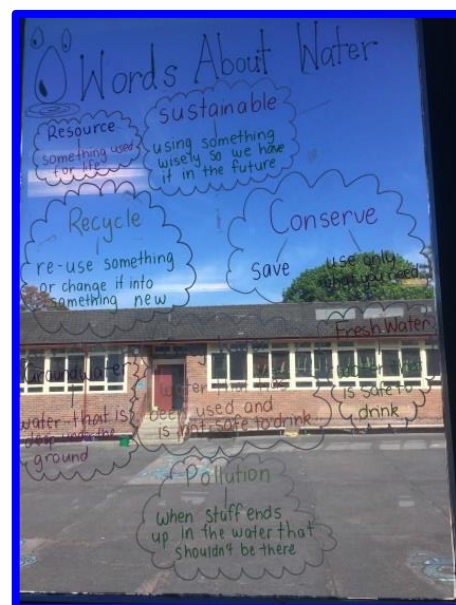
Water has three states - solid, liquid, gas.
