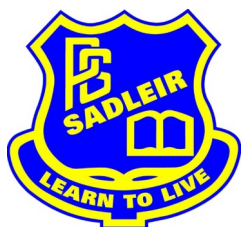

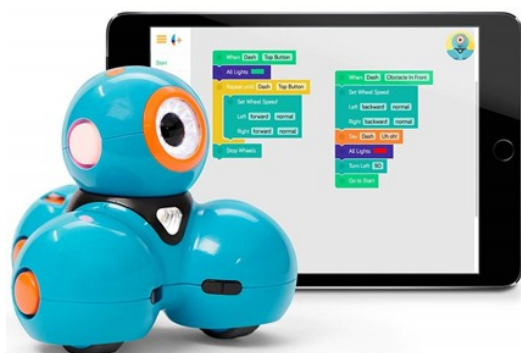

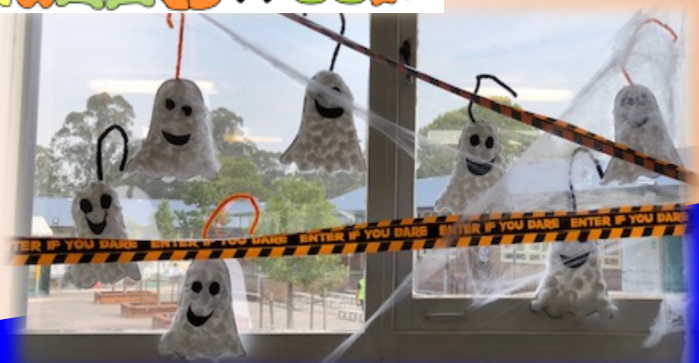

NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy

The *NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy* is all about giving students across NSW a taste for healthy foods and to make the healthy choice, the easy choice. The Strategy addresses NSW school canteens to support healthy growth and development of students.

All NSW public schools are required to transition to the *NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy* by the end of 2019.

The Strategy has a set of *Food and Drink Criteria* that outlines a healthy school canteen. It applies to all foods and drinks provided in NSW school canteens and vending machines. Every item sold in our canteen **MUST** have a star rating of 3.5 stars or above and our total menu items must have a minimum ratio of 75% everyday items to 25% occasional items.

To enable parents and students to make an easier, informed choice from our menu, our everyday items, that are the healthy options, are coloured green and the occasional items are coloured yellow.

Star ratings are also displayed for each item on our menu. We hope you are enjoying our new, fresher menu and for any queries or suggestions, please see our Canteen staff or Mrs Shashati in the Community Room.
