## Principal Report

We have had a fantastic start to the year with great learning P-6. In 2019, students will be participating in vertical leadership groups every second Friday. This peer support leadership program enables stage 3 students to teach important skills to younger students. Older students have the opportunity to engage with younger students and make positive connections across the school.

Last week, Early Stage 1 held a 'Meet the Families' afternoon. The session was very successful, with many mothers, fathers, grandparents, brothers, sisters and friends attending and joining in the classroom activities. It was great to see everyone. Kindergarten, this year, have settled in extremely well. Many students were very familiar with Sadleir Public School with 34 of the 41 students attended our preschool. Many students know each other well and are confident at school.

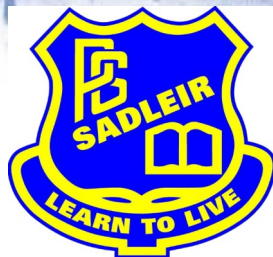

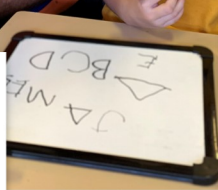

***Other teams had a bye for the first week of the season.***

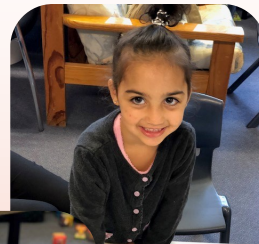
