NAID^{OC} Week

NAIDOC Week celebrations are usually held around the country each July to celebrate the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. Sadleir Public School celebrated NAIDOC Week in Week 7, 29th August to 2nd September.

This year's NAIDOC theme, Get Up! Stand Up! Show Up! Pays respect to a proud history of resistance and activism by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. It recognises our First Nations Peoples' resilience and strength and celebrates those who have driven and led significant change in their communities over generations.

Our celebrations included a special presentation by Kevin Cosgrove and Aunty Carol Brown for all of our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students and Stage 3. Kevin and Aunty Carol showed the students a documentary about how a replica Nawie canoe was made by students from Lawrence Hargrave School.









Our NAIDOC Assembly was held on Tuesday with deadly performances by Ashcroft High School's Boys' and Girls' Aboriginal Dance groups. Mr Ralph accepted two framed Aboriginal language maps on behalf of the school. These maps, created by David R Horton, attempt to represent the language, social or nation groups of Aboriginal Australia. One is for our hall and the other for the office
