NAIDOC Week

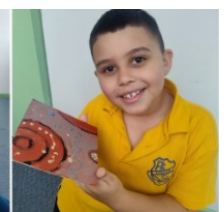
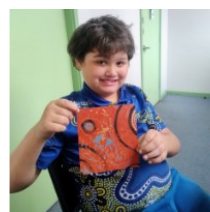
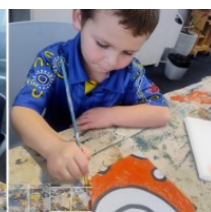
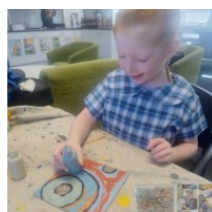
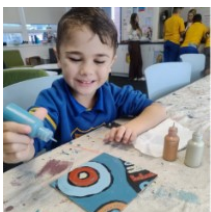
On Friday, July 4th, our school celebrated NAIDOC Week, recognising the history, culture, and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. The day was filled with engaging workshops and performances that deepened our understanding of Indigenous cultures.

Students participated in an assembly and took part in the Dharunga Dance Program, where they learned Wiradjuri and Dharug words and engaged in a cleansing dance. This program connected students to Aboriginal culture through a choreographed dance set to a song by Isaac Bamblett, a Bundjalung and Wiradjuri man. The song, performed in the Wiradjuri language, pays tribute to red gum trees, symbolising guidance, protection, and cleansing.



Throughout the day, students experienced a ceremonial paint-up with ochre, participated in a sweeping ceremony, and explored Aboriginal dance as a form of storytelling. The celebration culminated in a travelling circle where students showcased their choreographed dances, demonstrating their respect for Indigenous culture.

Our NAIDOC Week celebration was a wonderful success, fostering a greater appreciation for the rich heritage of Australia's First Nations peoples. Thank you to everyone who contributed to making this event memorable!

Canberra Camp

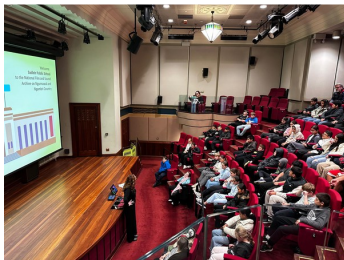
